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## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION TO RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES AND PROPERTY OWNERS

Stamford Interceptor Trunk Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation

What is happening?	Niagara Region is proceeding with improvements to the Stamford Intercepto Trunk Sanitary Sewer along the Ontario Power Generation Hydro Canal between Dorchester Road to approximately 700 metres North of Portage Road in the City of Niagara Falls.
When does this begin?	<b>Pre-condition Inspection: Immediately</b> Pre-condition building inspection surveys of properties located near the proposed site will start immediately and will continue over the next few weeks. This notice also serves as an introduction to the pre-construction survey company, OZA Group Inc.
	The pre-condition survey requires a video and/or photographic record of the building's interior and exterior condition prior to construction. OZA Group Inc has been retained to complete the pre-condition survey and representatives from OZA Group Inc. will have identification with them.
	<b>Construction Activities:</b> Construction is expected to start in late March 2019 and is expected to be completed by July 2019.
	Your cooperation regarding these inspections and construction matters is greatly appreciated.
Where?	<ul> <li>The construction work will consist of:</li> <li>Replacement of 80 metres of concrete sewer and various manholes along the Regional Stamford Interceptor Sewer, Niagara Falls</li> <li>Rehabilitation/Relining of 2.4 km of concrete sewer and manholes along the Regional Stamford Interceptor Sewer, Niagara Falls</li> </ul>
What can I expect?	Residents can expect construction vehicles and related truck traffic, and a degree of construction-related noise, dust and short-term inconvenience. Odours from the resin used to line the sewer may be noticeable during this work. Although low levels of this harmless odour may be noticeable at times, it presents no risk to human health.
	Construction and traffic signage will be posted and public services such as emergency services, garbage/recycling collection and school buses will be advised of the construction work.
